Cost

Foiled Again will be subsidising the costs of the trip. The final costs to you are as follows:

Adult admission: £15.00

Adult train ticket: £20.00

Junior admission: £7.00

Junior train ticket: £16.00

Total Junior: £23.00 (less deposit of £5)

What do I do now?

1. Arrive at Derby train station by 7am so that you can collect your train tickets from a Committee Member. We will be getting the 7.21am to St Pancras London.
2. Please bring the balance of monies owed on the day (cash or cheque made payable to Foiled Again) and give this to Harriet.
3. Please bring money on the day to buy lunch at the Tower restaurant.
4. Please come suitably attired- comfortable shoes, coat in case of inclement weather...

Itinerary for Foiled Again Club Trip to the Tower of London

1. Meet at Derby train station at **7am** so that you can collect your train tickets from a Committee Member.
2. **7.21am** train to London St Pancras.
3. Arrive at St Pancras at 9am. Take the Circle Line to Tower Hill.
4. Those members traveling separately please meet us outside the Ticket Office at 9.15am.
5. Committee member to collect tickets for the Tower.
6. 10am Join the Yeoman Warder (aka Beefeater!) tour and hear exciting tales of intrigue, imprisonment, execution and torture from the Tower's past (60 mins)
7. Experience the history of the Tower through live costumed re-enactments (timings vary, usually approximately 15 mins).
8. See the famous ravens next to the White Tower (10 mins).
9. Decide who murdered the Little Princes in the Bloody Tower (15 mins).
10. Explore the story of how the Tower was attacked and defended in our interactive Fortress displays (10 mins).
11. Lunch in the Tower restaurant.
12. 2.15pm Tour of the White Tower built by William the Conqueror, which today houses displays from the Royal Armouries' collection (45 mins).
13. Walk through the surprisingly rich colours and comfortable furnishings of the Medieval Palace (20 mins).
14. Discover the extraordinary prisoner graffiti in the Beauchamp Tower (10 mins).
15. See instruments of torture in the Lower Wakefield Tower (10 mins).
16. 3.45pm leave the Tower and travel back to St Pancras catching the 4.26pm back to Derby.
