

Demonstrate:

(with coach or partner)

While following your partner's steps forward and backward:

- Maintain step-lunge distance and on one of your partner's steps forward, attack with:
 - a. Beat Direct with an explosive lunge
 - b. Beat Disengage with an explosive lunge
- 2 As your partner attacks with a lunge, step back to avoid the attack and attack with a lunge as your partner returns to guard
- 3 Parry your partner's attack with a Circular Parry of Sixte and hit with a Disengage Riposte - if your Circular Parry is deceived, then Parry Quarte with a Direct Riposte

From a stationary position:

- 4 Engage your partner's blade in:
 - a. Sixte, and attack with Coulé Direct and Coulé Disengage and an accelerating lunge
 - b. Quarte, and attack with Coulé Direct and Coulé Disengage and an accelerating lunge
- 5 Diagonal Parries
- 6 Direct Attack, with Flèche
- 7 Engage your partner's blade in Sixte, Quarte, Octave and Septime, with a step forward
